

The After-School Program is Monday and Tuesday afternoons at the San Francisco Day School, located at 350 Masonic @ Golden Gate Avenue. The program runs from 3:30 pm - 5:30 pm.

Tutoring is on Monday afternoons. Tutors come at least once a week and are paired up with one or two students. Students who need extra help in a particular academic subject receive individualized one-on-one tutoring, while other students may come for general homework help.

Enrichment Classes are held on Tuesday afternoons. Volunteers have the choice of teaching Math or English. Mentor teachers create the curriculum for teachers and train them before each unit. The curriculum is provided, but it is up to the teacher to plan each class and make it engaging for the students. There will be no homework for you to grade, but there will be planning for you to do for each class session.

Office Volunteers are a major help to Day School Summerbridge. Office volunteers work on planning events and have administrative duties along side the full-time office staff.
